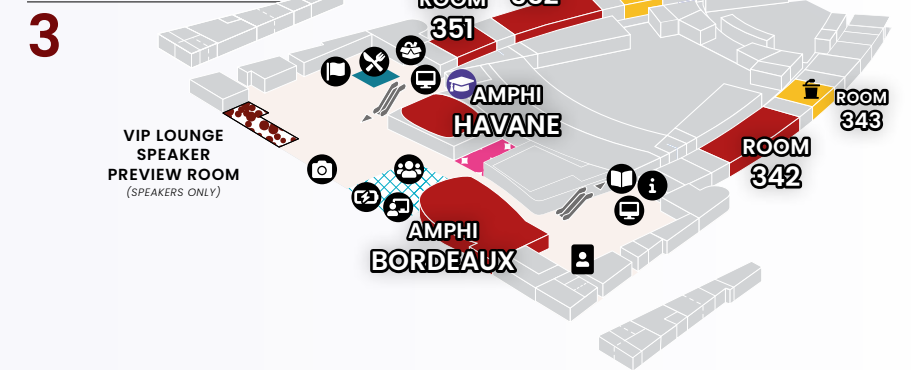
## CIRCULATION MAP

### The role of ultrasound in aesthetic practices

The most exiting application of ultrasound in filler medicine is seeing the injection material being delivered in real time. When you observe that for the first time it is a real whoo-effect. But in general physicians tend to use it for prevention. So, prior to injecting in a certain area they inspect that with duplex to see if there are any arteries in the way.

Most important is to stay away from arteries to avoid intravascular injection. But to assess an area anatomically can also help. For instance, we see many filler injections inside the parotid gland. Measuring the subcutaneous space in the area makes you aware that the margins are thin, sometimes only 2 millimeters.

Checking your treatment is another important use. You are able to detect exactly the location the filler is injected. That is sometimes confronting, but it really helps you to improve your technique.

It is not easy to start with ultrasound in your practice. You have to be committed to do so. If you are, you need to buy a device and read about this subject. But reading only is not enough. It really helps to take classes to delve deeper, like we are doing during IMCAS World Congress 2022.










## COI POLICY

IMCAS insists on complete independence between instructional (or scientific) courses and the industry support of its congresses.

### WHAT IS A CONFLICT OF INTEREST (COI)?

A COI is a situation in which a person who is lecturing at an IMCAS congress has a sufficient personal and/or financial relationship with a commercial or non-commercial entity that may bias the content of his or her presentation.

IMCAS speakers are required to disclose any and all potentially distorting influences before a lecture so the audience are aware of certain biases that may be included in the learning content.

### WHO IS AFFECTED BY THE COI POLICY?

The COI policy applies to anyone who is a speaker during the congress or contributes to the development of the scientific program. This includes all members of the Scientific Board and all faculty members.

### WHAT IF THE SPEAKER DECLARES "NO CONFLICT OF INTEREST"?

"No Conflict of Interest" means that neither the speaker nor any members of his or her immediate family has a significant financial relationship or affiliation with the product, device or company involved.

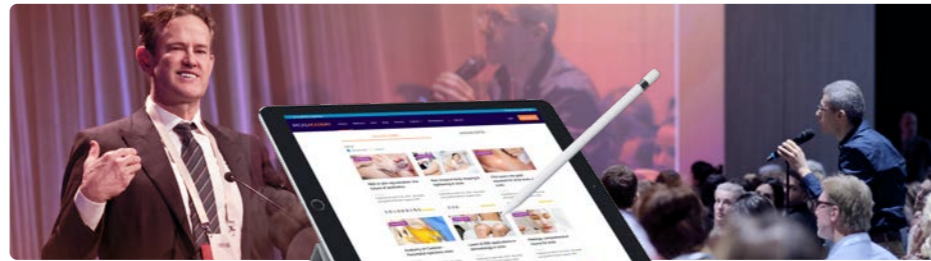

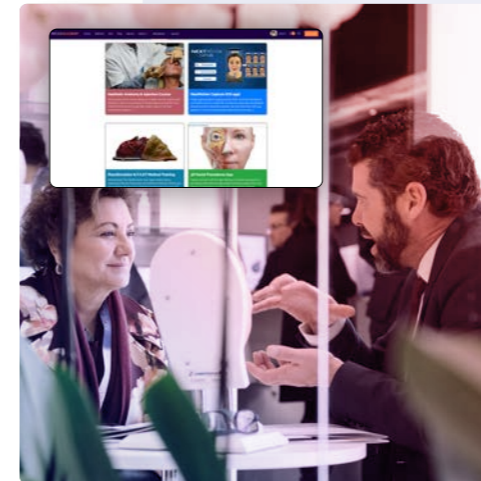

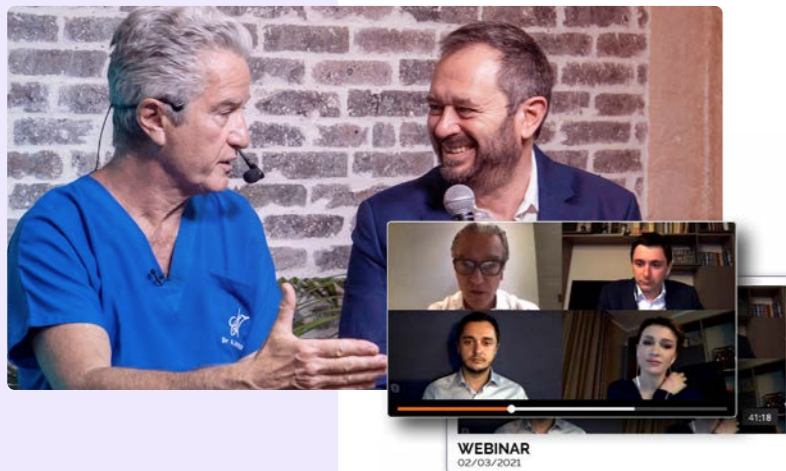

# REGISTRATION GUIDELINES

Access to the congress and sessions is subject to a number of regulations that aim to guarantee the scientific independence of the congresses and preserve it from any commercial interest or influence.

A precise badge policy has been implemented specifying the rules of admittance to the different areas of the congress, complying with the criteria required by the CME accreditation organizations. According to each badge type a full or partial access is issued.

A distinction is made between "Physician" and "Non-physician". For the latter, the level of medical study determines whether concerned attendees are entitled to a full or partial access. Upon registration, all necessary proofs of practice should be uploaded.

IMCAS is authorized to take measures which may lead to the withdrawal of the badge and the denial of access to the congress area if the badge policy is violated.

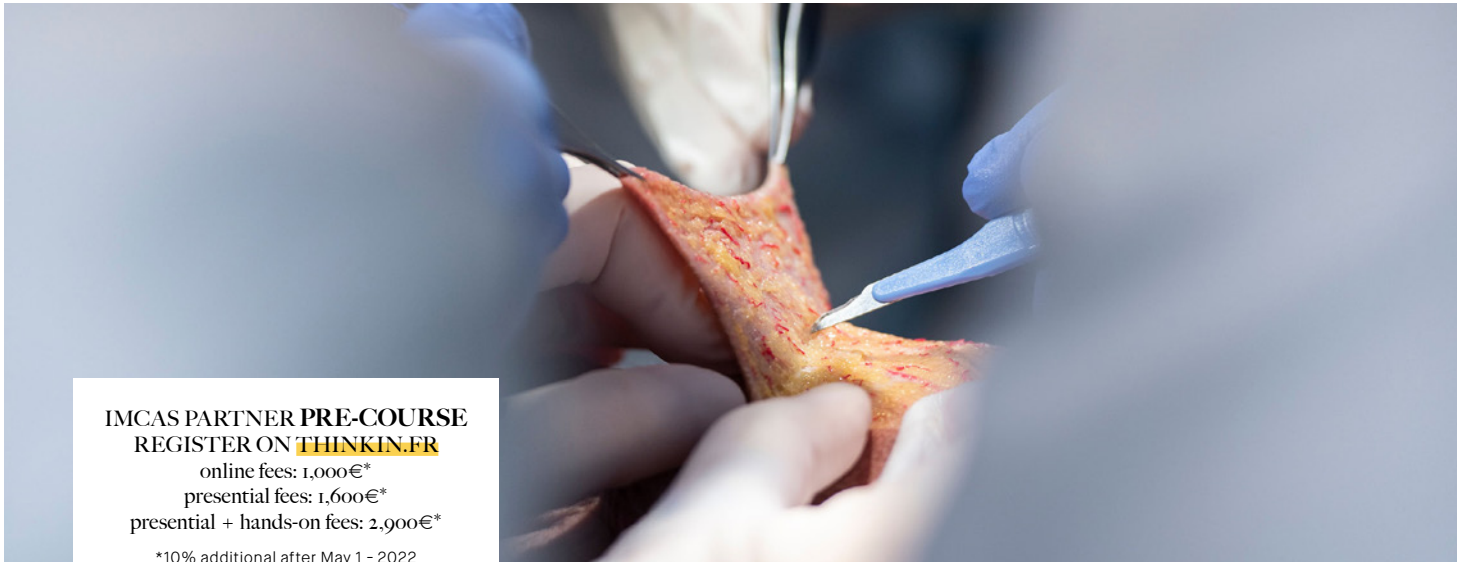

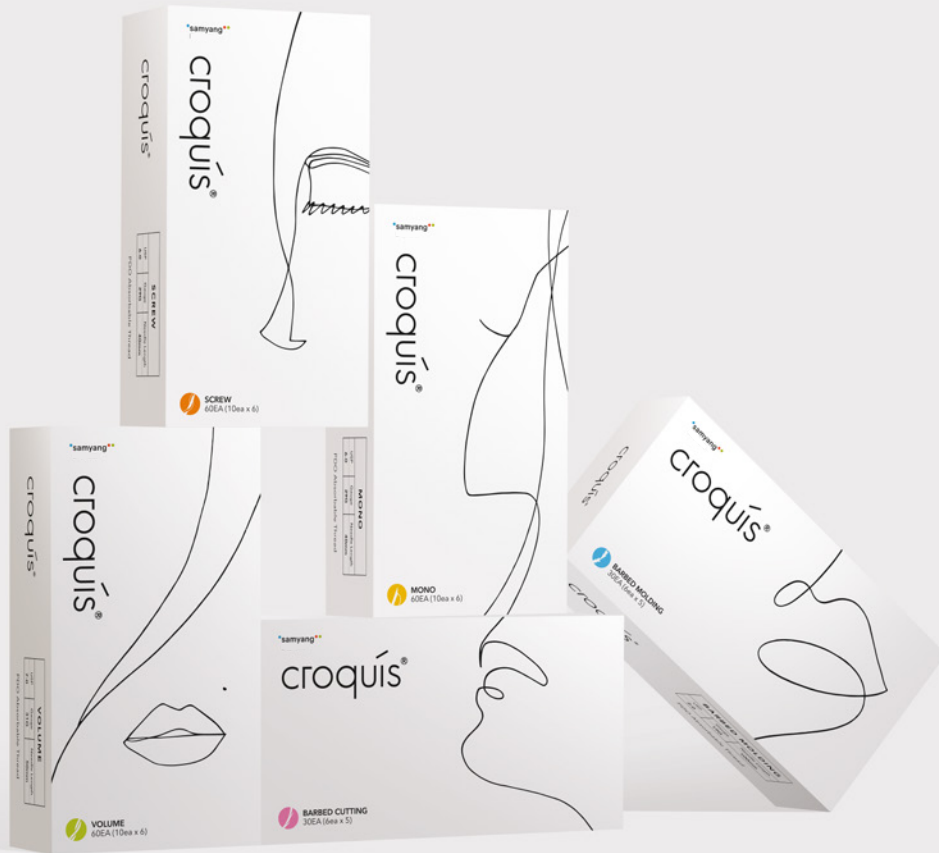
